

Situation Retrofit in plaster, masonry, block or concrete wall







- Inspect collar to ensure springs, fuse-links and intumescent material have not been damaged during transport.
- **2.** Drill or core a hole through the wall.
- During the pipe installation slide the SNAP GAS collar onto the pipe.




IMPORTANT The SNAP GAS collar is installed correctly by orienting the fusible link on the spring away from the floor or wall which is to be protected.


4. If installing in plasterboard wall: Drill and fix SNAP GAS collar to either side of wall.

> If installing in masonry, block or concrete wall: Mark and drill mounting holes. Masonry anchors/other approved fixing can be used to secure collar to each side.

5. Install pipe. Tighten anchors or nuts if using threaded bar. Do not overtighten nuts.




